

Conceived by Carla Canales and led by Kurt Crowley, also the music director of Broadway's *Hamilton*, *Hear Her Song* is the inspirational artwork of a team of talented composers and musical artists. These artists collaborated to create original songs that deliver new, powerful insights into the nature of women's leadership and the challenges women face. Since its inception in 2017, *Hear Her Song* has commissioned 40 songs, honored 38 leaders, employed 65 artists, and collaborated with 10 partner organizations, all with 11 countries involved.

The performance will take on **Sunday, May 19 at 4:00 p.m.** at the Hammer Theatre Center's intimate Hammer4 venue, 101 Paseo De San Antonio, San José.
